Report a bully: If your student is having an issue with bullying at school, you can report that issue here. Please be as specific as possible when submitting your report. The name of the student making the report is not required. However, if no name is given, a full investigation of the issue cannot take place. All reports will be dealt with by the school counselors or deans. The names of the students making the reports will be held confidential. Please make certain to include the following information in your report:

- Name of the student making the report (This is optional, however, if no name is given, a full investigation of the issue cannot take place.)
- Name(s) and grade(s) of the student(s) being reported.
- Details of the issue being reported.
- Parent contact information - preferred phone number and/or email address. (This is optional, but will need to be included if you wish school personnel to contact you regarding your concerns.)
